The first of five upcoming reports is now published and, to kick us off, we are excited to invite you to our first webinar discussing the publication:

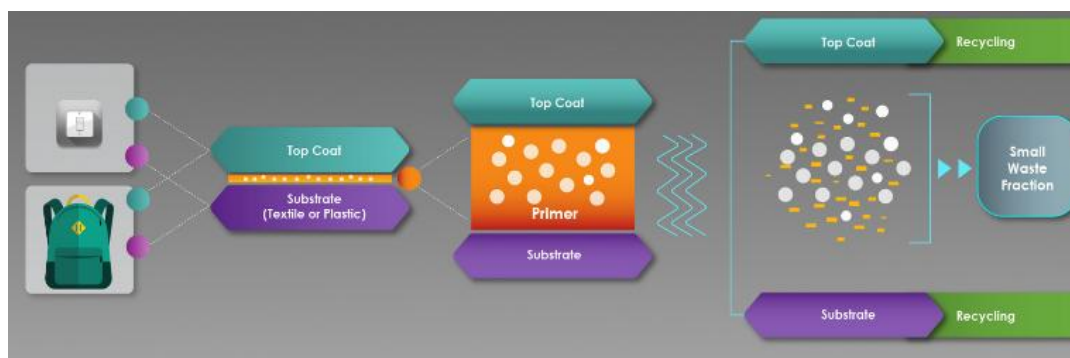
Municipal Organic Waste – A Global Perspective on Production and Recycling

DECOAT: What do you know about End of Life for Plastics & Textiles?

The EU Horizon 2020 project, to which ISWA is a proud partner, DECOAT, needs your expertise!

A short questionnaire has been designed with the aim of collecting data on End of Life stage of TEXTILE and PLASTIC for the purpose of conducting life cycle assessment of decoating solutions.

The main goal of DECOAT is to enable circular use of coated textiles and plastic parts, which are typically not recyclable. DECOAT strives to develop technologies to debond coatings from the parts (to decoat them), and to further demonstrate the viability of these technologies in a continuous recycling pilot plant.
